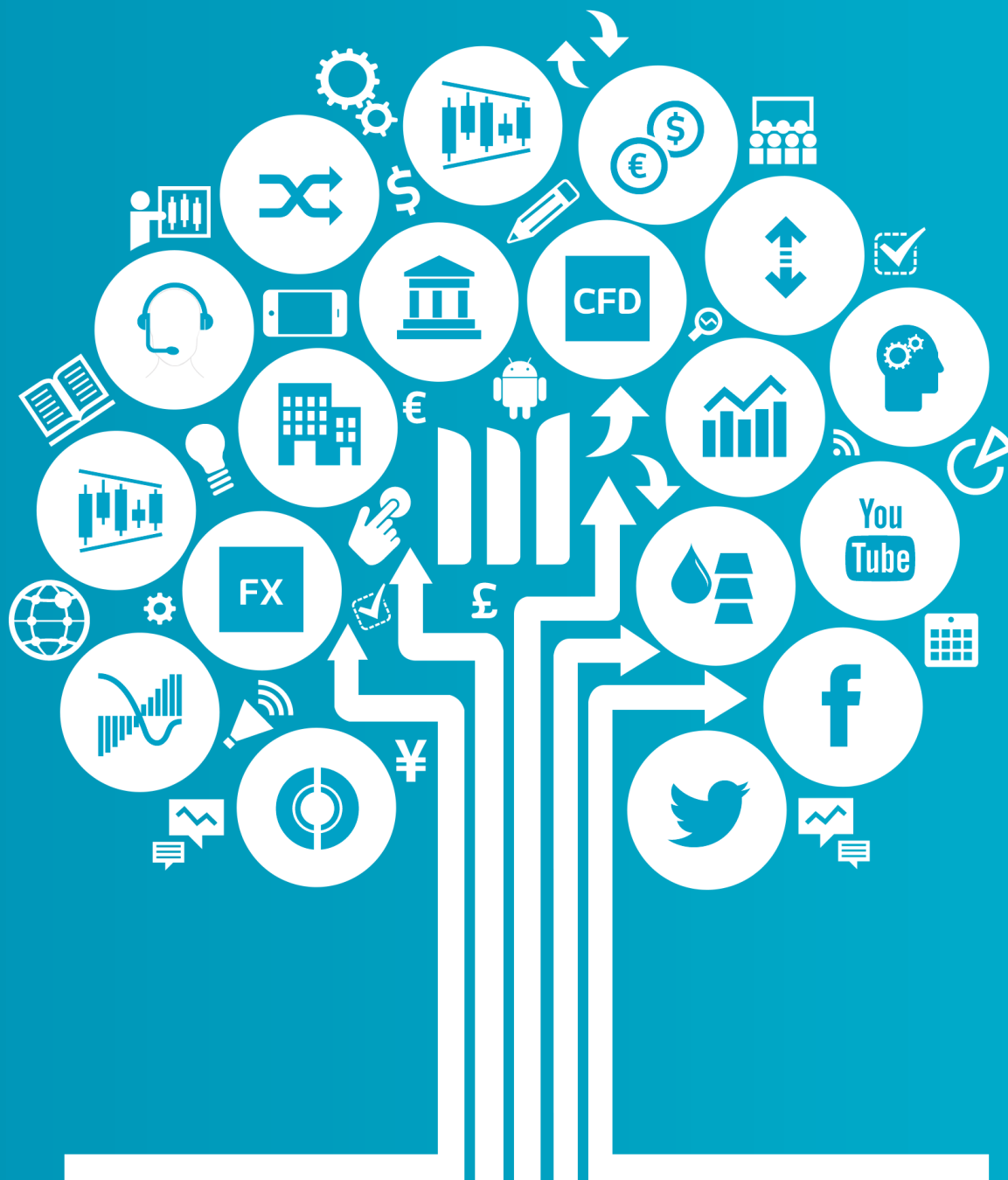

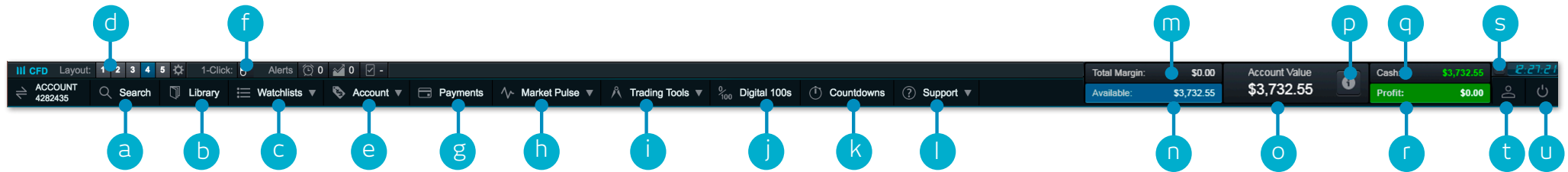

# 1. Navigation toolbar and account

Access our advanced tools and features, switch layouts, set preferences and monitor your account value



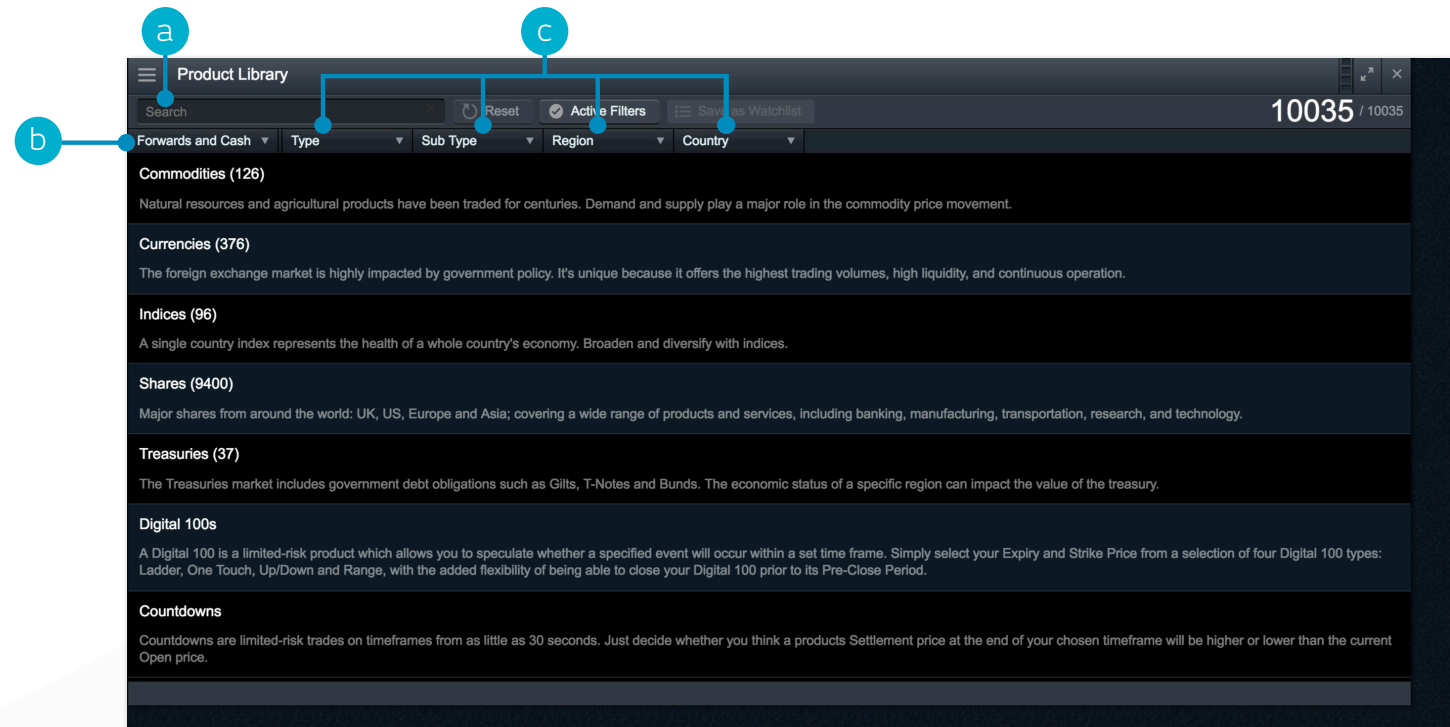
- a. Search for any product using the built-in search tool
- b. Open the Product Library to conduct a more advanced search and filter
- c. Open an existing watchlist containing popular products, or create a new one
- d. Switch between different saved screen layouts. Set layout to auto save or not through settings icon
- e. Manage your existing Positions and Pending Orders, and view your trading history
- f. Switch between 1-Click Trading modes
- g. Access details on how to fund your account
- h. Get the latest market information with our Market Pulse tools, including Market Calendar and Reuters News
- i. Access our range of trading tools to spot potential trading opportunities within the markets, as they happen
- j. Trade digital 100s with limited risk and short timeframes, starting from just five minutes.
- k. Place straightforward, fast-paced trades over short timeframes on popular indices, commodities and FX pairs with Countdowns.
- l. Platform training, feedback and Live Help
- m. The amount of funds currently being used as Total Margin
- n. The funds you have available to open new Positions
- o. The current value of your trading account
- p. View details of your current Close-Out Levels – if these are reached your Positions may be closed

## 2. Product Library

Use the search and filter functions in the product library to find the products you want to trade

- Type in the name of the product you want to search for
- Filter by cash and/or forward products
- Filter products by type, region, price performance and volatility
- Click on a product's buy or sell price to open an order ticket

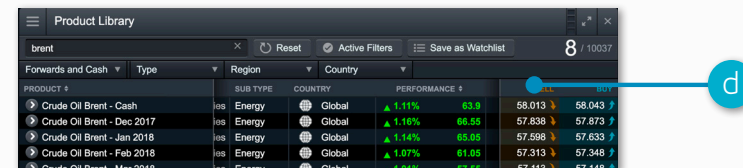

- Digital 100s**: A Digital 100 is a limited-risk product which allows you to speculate whether a specified event will occur within a set time frame. Simply select your Expiry and Strike Price from a selection of four Digital 100 types: Ladder, One Touch, Up/Down and Range, with the added flexibility of being able to close your Digital 100 prior to its Pre-Close Period.
- Countdowns**: Countdowns are limited-risk trades on timeframes from as little as 30 seconds. Just decide whether you think a products Settlement price at the end of your chosen timeframe will be higher or lower than the current Open price.

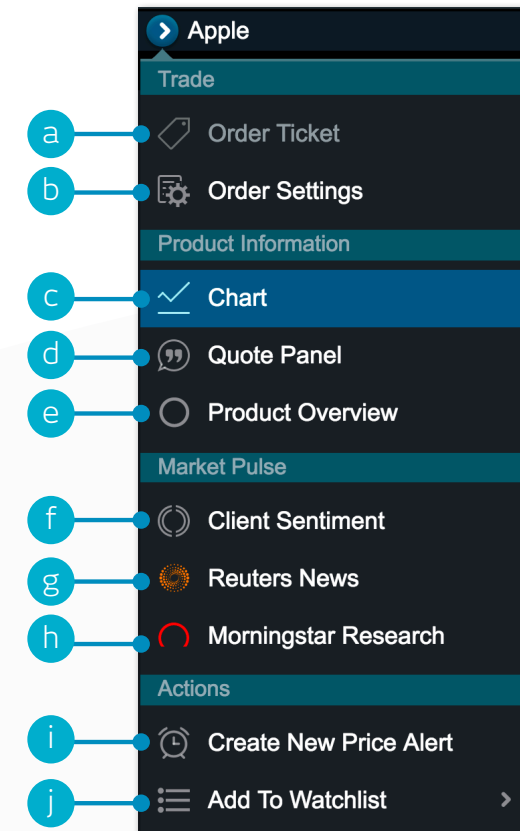

### 3. Drop-down menu navigation

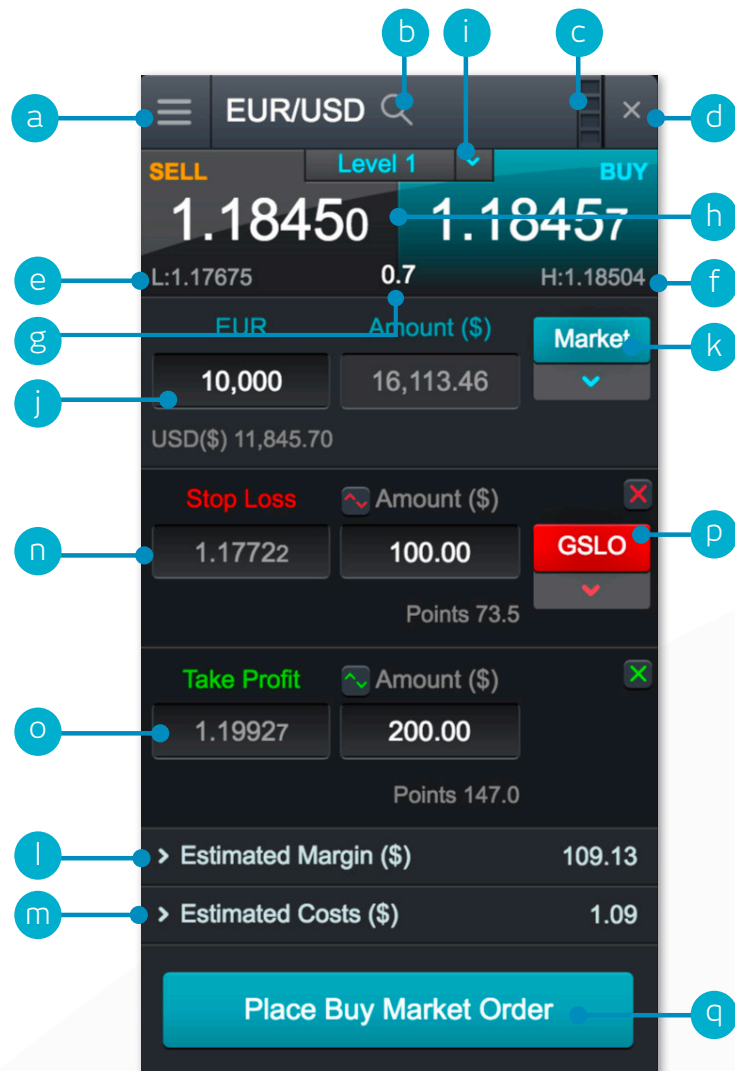
Click the drop-down menu icon next to a product name to unlock product-specific options

- a. Open a new order ticket for the product you've accessed the menu through
- b. Set order defaults for this specific product, such as default risk management and order quantity
- c. Open a new chart for the product
- d. Open a quote panel with Buy and Sell Prices, daily highs and lows plus real-time spread. Note that the screen price is not necessarily the price your trade will be executed at
- e. View product information such as Trading Hours, margin requirements, Holding Costs and real-time spread
- f. View Client Sentiment for the product, related to both client count and position value, updated every minute. The client sentiment feature is indicative, has inherent limitations and may be out of date at any given time
- g. Open a Reuters News feed containing only news that's relevant to the product
- h. Access Morningstar equity research to view current cash fundamentals and Morningstar's proprietary Fair Value Estimate, which is the Morningstar analysts' estimate of the potential value of the share.
- i. Set and manage price alerts. View the real-time price difference between your alerts and the current market price
- j. Add this product to one of your watchlists or create a new one



## 4. Place a trade using our Order ticket

Click any Buy or Sell Price on the platform to launch an Order ticket

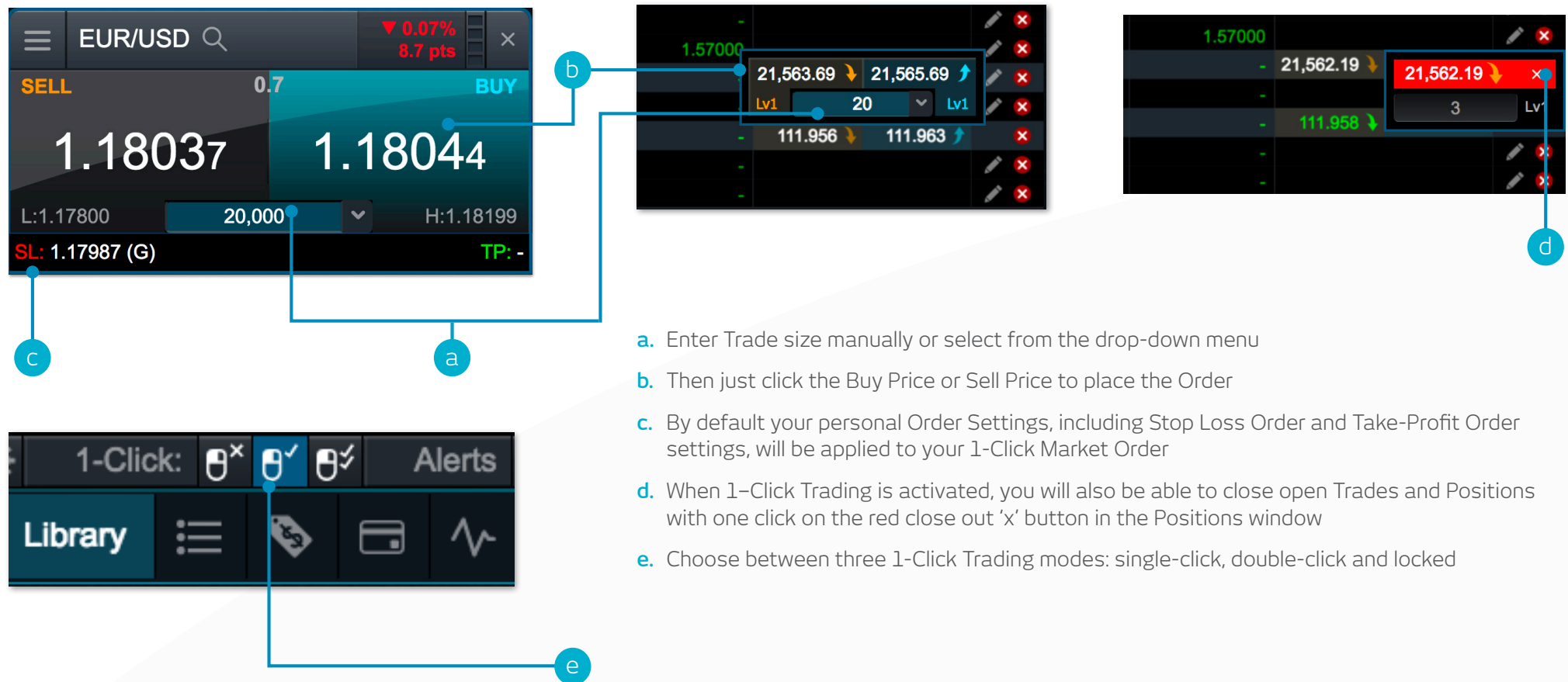


- a. You can open a product's drop-down options menu to access product information, Reuters News, live charting, module linking and much more
- b. Use the search function to change the product shown in the Order ticket
- c. Link two or more modules together, so that when you change the product in one module, the other module(s) will automatically update to show the new product
- d. Close Order ticket
- e. The lowest Price this product has reached during today's trading session
- f. The highest Price this product has reached during today's trading session
- g. The live spread between the Buy and Sell Price
- h. Click on the Buy or Sell Price to switch between a buy or a sell Order
- i. The Price Depth relevant to your Order quantity. Click here to show the Price Ladder. Larger trade sizes can attract a wider spread
- j. Enter the number of Units or exposure you want to buy or sell
- k. Change the Order type - choose between Market, Limit or Stop Entry Orders
- l. The estimated amount of margin required to enter this Position
- m. The estimated costs involved in entering this Position
- n. Add a Stop Loss Order to this Position to protect against adverse price movements
- o. Add a Take Profit Order to this Position to set a Target Price
- p. Set a regular Stop Loss, Trailing Stop Loss or a Guaranteed Stop Loss Order (GSLO) by Price or points distance. Trailing Stop Loss Orders follow favourable price movements by a set number of points. GSLOs guarantee an exit price, for a premium
- q. Submit your Trade



## 5. 1-Click Trading

The 1-Click Trading feature allows you to open or close a Trade with just one click. Activate this feature in the main toolbar or under Order Settings. Once activated, 1-Click Trading is turned on for all Price buttons by default.

- a.** Enter Trade size manually or select from the drop-down menu. This is shown in the main trading window where the trade size is set to 20,000.
- b.** Then just click the Buy Price or Sell Price to place the Order. This is shown in the main trading window where the Buy Price (1.18044) is highlighted.
- c.** By default your personal Order Settings, including Stop Loss Order and Take-Profit Order settings, will be applied to your 1-Click Market Order. This is shown in the main trading window where the Stop Loss (SL) is set to 1.17987 (G) and Take-Profit (TP) is set to -.
- d.** When 1-Click Trading is activated, you will also be able to close open Trades and Positions with one click on the red close out 'x' button in the Positions window. This is shown in the Positions window where the red 'x' button is highlighted.
- e.** Choose between three 1-Click Trading modes: single-click, double-click and locked. This is shown in the main toolbar where the 1-Click Trading mode is set to single-click.

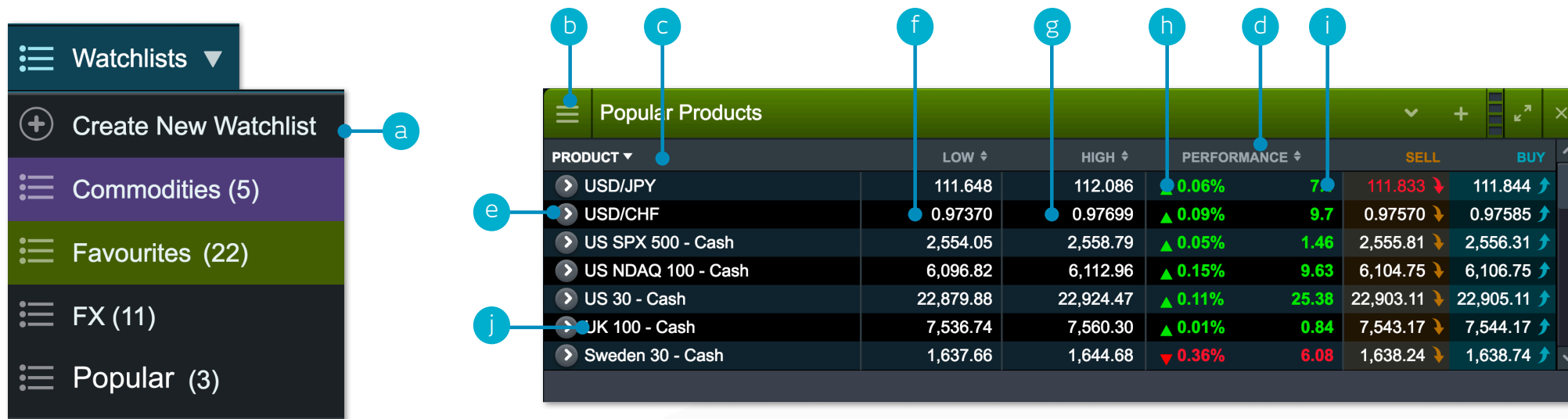

## 8. Advanced Charting

The highly customisable, intuitive charting interface includes over 115 drawing tools and technical indicators and chart pattern recognition capability

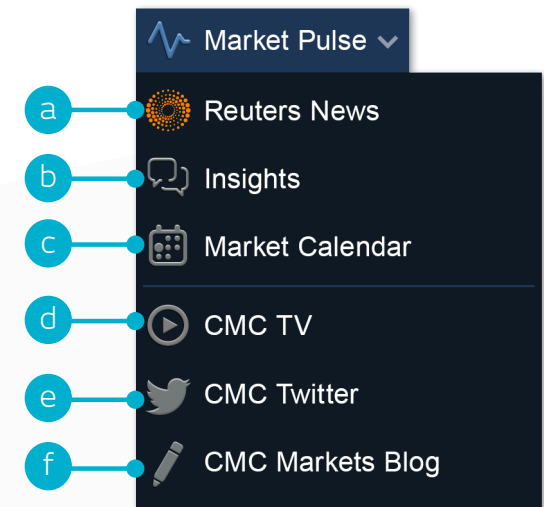
- a. Open the product options menu to access product-specific information, Client Sentiment, Reuters News and much more
- b. Blue triangle: Click here to close or amend this Position - you can edit risk management directly on the chart
- c. Open a value box area to see the open, high, low and close values, plus greater detail on technical indicator values
- d. Change the interval and timeframe of your chart history using a selection of options
- e. Choose between different chart types, including candlestick, renko and point and figure charts
- f. Add technical studies and overlays to your chart to identify potential technical trading set-ups
- g. Change settings, customise your technical indicator and view chart education
- h. Add a selection of drawing tools to your chart to identify strategic price levels and highlight areas of interest
- i. Add technical pattern and candlestick recognition to your chart – see the results evolve in real time
- j. Turn trade plot on or off
- k. Set trading tools as a favourite by selecting the star icon
- l. Save up to five charts for each product and access them any time
- m. Open chart settings to set chart defaults, presets and other settings



## 9. Market Pulse – news, Insights and Market Calendar

Get the latest news and updates on what's moving the markets with our Market Pulse tools

- a. The Reuters News module feeds live headlines and articles across all asset types straight into the platform as they are published. Reuters News can be filtered according to products within a Watchlist
- b. View a live stream of market updates direct from our team of global market analysts
- c. Use the Market Calendar to view the latest economic data releases from across the globe and set reminders for future updates
- d. Access our financial channel with global market analysis and strategy for the active trader
- e. Keep up to date with the latest major market events by following our targeted Twitter feed
- f. Up-to-date commentary on the financial markets from our Market Analysts in Singapore and around the world



# 10. Digital 100s

Speculate with limited risk on whether or not an event will occur by the end of a set timeframe. 'Buy' the digital 100 if you believe the event will occur, or 'sell' if you don't think it will occur. The buy and sell prices are always set between 0 and 100 – if the event occurs the digital 100 settles at 100; if it doesn't occur, it settles at 0.



- a. Open the digital 100s product grid (also accessible via the product library)
- b. Each product square shows the current settlement price, the number of open positions on each product, the daily performance and the expiry date and time
- c. Filter products by digital 100 type, expiry or asset class. Sort by A-Z, or best/worst performers
- d. This is the current settlement price – the digital 100 trade is settled against this price
- e. Select 'Overview' to view available expiries and digital 100 types, trading hours, and trading and position limits for the selected product
- f. Remove pre-order confirmations, change default order sizes, set default chart types and presets
- g. Change digital 100 type, or timeframe
- h. This is the current selected digital 100 expiry time
- i. The order ticket shows the digital 100 buy and sell prices for the selected strike, digital 100 type and expiry
- j. Enter your order size or dial it up and down using the + or - icons
- k. This is the amount of cash that will be deducted when this digital 100 position is entered. It's the maximum amount of capital at risk
- l. This is the maximum profit potential for this digital 100 position
- m. Select this button to place the digital 100 order
- n. Switch between 'Positions' and 'History' view
- o. This is the strike price for this digital 100 position – select to open its chart
- p. Current profit or loss of the aggregated digital 100 position
- q. Current digital 100 buy and sell prices for the strike price shown at 'O'

# Digital 100s strikes and types:

- a. This is the currently selected strike price, shown on the chart and highlighted on the strike list
- b. This is the digital 100 expiry time. The green and red shaded areas show where the settlement price needs to be at expiry to make a profit or loss
- c. The strike list shows available digital 100 prices for the selected expiry and type for a range of strikes
- d. Our full range of charting tools to support your trading decisions

## Digital 100 types:

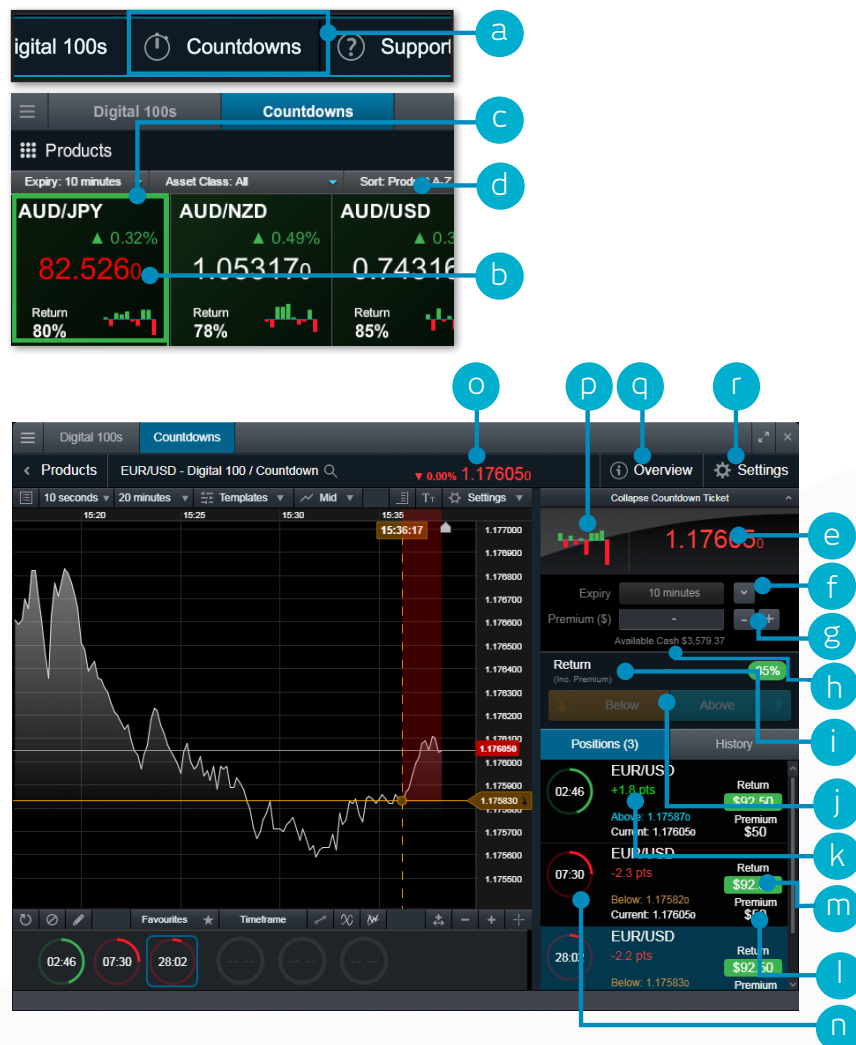
- Ladder: Will the settlement price be at or above a specified strike price at the end of the digital 100 expiry?
- Up/Down: Will the settlement price be at or above the previous period's close at the end of the digital 100 expiry?
- One Touch: Will the settlement price reach a specific strike price before or at the end of the digital 100 expiry?
- Range: Will the settlement price be within a specified range at the end of the digital 100 expiry?





# 11. Countdowns

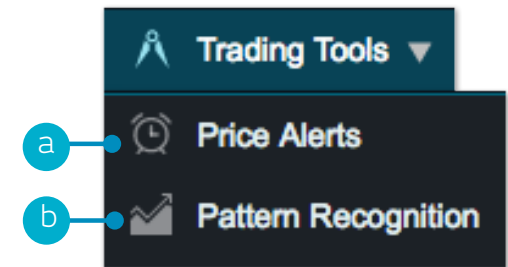
Countdowns provide a fast, straightforward way to trade with limited risk on the short-term price movements of financial markets



- Open the Countdowns product grid
- Each product square in the product grid shows the current Countdown price, the number of open positions on each product, the daily performance, the profit and the trend analyser tool. Click the square to launch an order ticket and chart
- Returns and trend data update automatically if you change the expiry timeframe
- Sort the product grid by a variety of different options
- The order ticket shows the current Countdown price. With Countdowns you decide whether you think the settlement price for this product will be above or below the current Countdown price at the end of your chosen expiry
- Select your expiry. Different expiries may have different profit percentages
- Enter your premium size or dial it up or down by set amounts with the +/- icons
- 'Available cash' is the amount you have available to place new Countdowns
- The profit amount is the total potential return if your Countdown is successful. It includes your original Premium
- Choose whether you think the settlement price will be above or below the current Countdown price at the end of your selected expiry. Click the relevant button to open your position
- The points difference between the current settlement price and your Countdown price
- Click any open position to see a live chart showing your chosen direction, your Countdown price and coloured shading that shows if you are winning or losing
- The Return amount and the Premium for this open position are shown here
- The Countdown clock will be coloured green, red or blue, depending on whether the position is winning, losing or a draw
- This is the current settlement price for this product
- The trend analyser draws the price action for the last 10 time intervals depending on expiry selected. For example, if a five-minute expiry is selected, each coloured bar represents the net price movement over five-minute intervals (12:00, 12:05, 12:10 etc.)
- Click to view details of Return percentages across different expiries if you win or draw, plus minimum and maximum Premium sizes and total position sizes
- Remove pre-order confirmations, change default order sizes, set default chart types

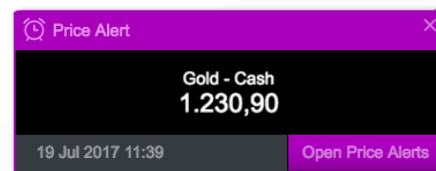
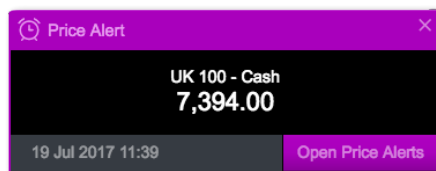

# 13. Settings

Ensure you set up your trading account to suit your individual needs by using the numerous inbuilt account preferences. Click on the User Preferences icon to access Account and Order Settings.

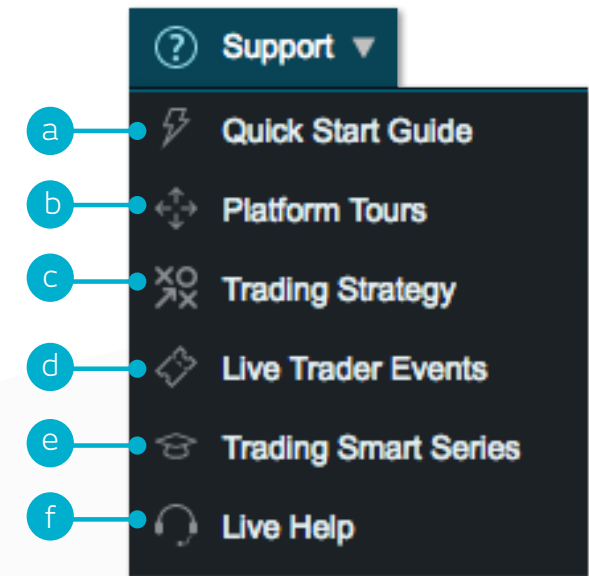
- Configure your preferred Order settings globally, by asset class or by specific products. Personalise settings on default Trade size, Boundaries, Forward Settlement Behaviour, 1-Click Trading, execution alerts, Stop Loss Orders, Take-Profit Orders, Limit Orders and Stop-Entry Orders
- Disable Account Netting to place separate long and short Trades on the same product at the same time. Select your preferred Account Close-Out method. Choose between 'Standard Account Close-Out' or 'Alternative Account Close-Out' ('Last in, first out', 'Largest Position Margin first' or 'Largest Position loss first')
