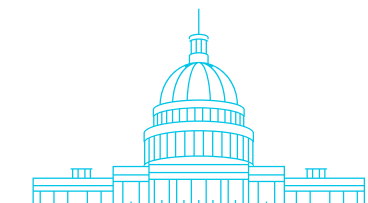


FIRST 100

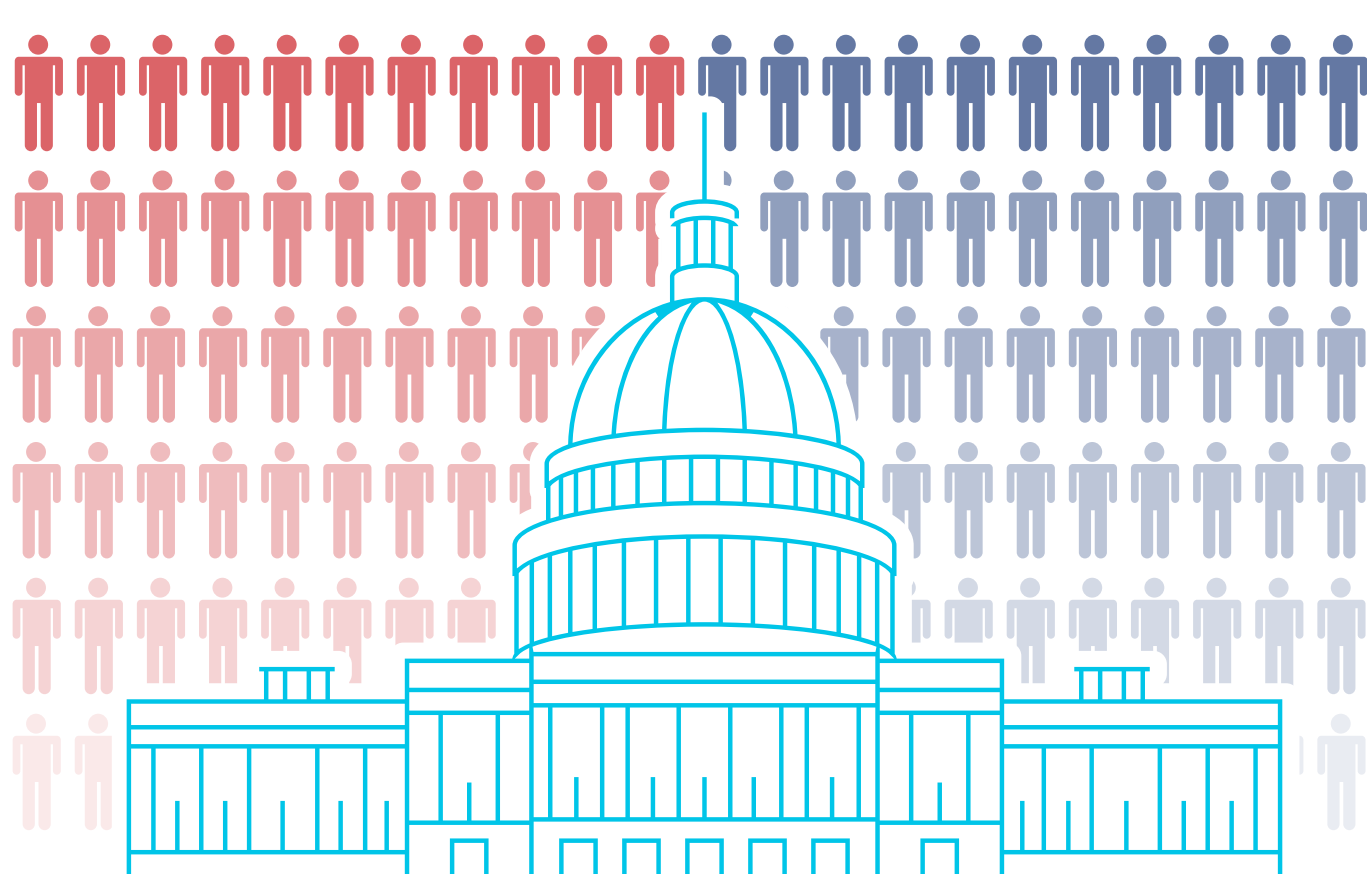

his legislative agenda as possible



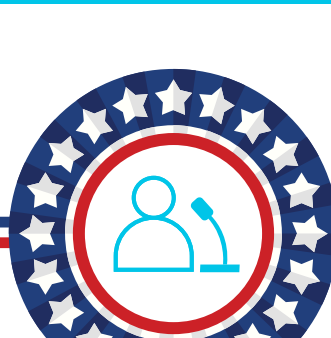
THE INAUGURATION



INAUGURATION takes
place 20 January 2017
on the steps of the
US Capitol building



The president-elect
will take an OATH
pledging fealty to the
US constitution



The president will
then deliver an
INAUGURAL ADDRESS



Meanwhile staff will be
MOVING OUT of the
White House to make room
for the new administration



Finally there is an
INAUGURAL BALL
and President Trump
begins his new job
